Camino Colibrí Housing Project





- housing for agricultural workers priority given to agricultural workers who were displaced by the 2020 wildfires
- Camino Colibrí is targeted to farmworkers and their families earning less than 60% AMI, with 41% of the units targeted to families with incomes below 50% AMI.
- Camino Colibrí is a new construction multifamily housing complex, consisting of seven (7) studios, ten (10) one-bedroom units, eleven (11) twobedroom units and six (6) three-bedroom units, including an onsite resident manager,
- Units will range in size from 621 to 1,181 square feet. There will be a centralized community room that will provide space for meetings, classes, gatherings and for the provision of a wide array of social services for the residents.







El Mercadito

El Mercadito is a vision born from our community, aiming to establish more spaces for gathering and celebrating our culture through food, music, art, and activities. For generations, our people have significantly contributed to Southern Oregon's economy and culture through essential roles in agriculture, timber, and tourism.

Despite our economic and cultural contribution to Southern Oregon, our communities have been disproportionately impacted by the ongoing climate and housing crises, leading to a loss of belonging and control over our future. That is why El Mercadito aims to uplift, center, and prioritize the well-being and participation of our Latinx, BIPOC, LGBTQIA+ and other marginalized communities.

The Oregon Individual Development Account (IDA) Initiative helps build hope for Oregonians with low incomes by providing matched savings opportunities, information about financial systems, and coaching that meets savers where they are at and supports their financial goals.

- Emergency Savings IDA Program
 - We are currently in our third year of funding and have enrolled 14 more families.
 - We are on track to distribute \$160,000 into our community through our IDA program.
- Our Family Farms Matched Savings Program for Housing
 - We have developed a matched savings program which will help farmworker fire surviving families save up to \$21,000 for a home.
